- Download this PDF from http://www.32oz.com/mirror/keyholder/ and print on a colorful sheet of 8.5"x11" 60 lb. copier paper.
- Cut the page into quarters, along the solid lines on the print. Keep this instruction quarter aside for reference - then pass it on to friends so they can make their own!
- 3. Fold each keyholder quarter in half, along the dotted line. With the black side facing up cut out the black area using good scissors or an xacto blade ensuring you cut through both sides of the paper. You should end up with 3 folded slips of paper, all shaped like the illustration to the right.



- 4. Laminate the resulting pieces of paper, making sure they remain folded, keeping 1/2" minimum distance from each other or the sides. Run it through the laminator twice, to ensure a good seal. You want to see the lamination touch itself in the channels we cut, and all along the outside of the paper.
- 5. Cut each slip out of the laminate along the dashed lines. Make 2 straight cuts along the dashed lines first. Then trim the ends just beyond the laminate seal to credit card size (3 3/8"), and finally cut out the key tabs.
- You should be able to slide 3 normal sized keys into each card, then into your wallet.
 Friction should be enough to keep the keys in your wallet under most circumstances, but YMMV.
- 7. You can write on the laminate with a permanent marker the names of the keys you store in each card on the black side, as well as your name & number on the front side for return in case of emergency.

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
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
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
