For those who don't get out of bed until after three o'clock, check out the Twilight Zone, hosted by Jessica Rabbit and Cathy Comet every Monday from midnight until three. The ocassional home of live bands (Dive), the Twilight Zone is the late night home of WKDU's Rave and House scene. 


