Raved all weekend and still haven't satisfied your techno hunger? Tune in to RAVE-FM every Monday from noon to three on WKDU 91.7 FM for a weekday dose of hardcore noise and pulsating brain sounds. DJ's Wink & Dior take over the airwaves of Drexel's student-run radio station to bring you the latest underground sounds. A techno treat for your ears, RAVE FM often features guest DJs (the ever-present Odyssey, Nigel Richards and others) plus mixed tapes provided by various local DJs and local techno artists including Drexel's own TECH-NEIN

All WKDU DJ's are students at Drexel and as such, they are at the mercy of their class schedules. RAVE-FM began on Thursdays in the afternoon, moved to Wednesdays, Tuesdays, and is stopping briefly on Monday's. Call WKDU and add your name to the mailing list to receive a WKDU quarterly schedule, or read about schedule changes right here.

A regular feature on WKDU is "Philly Happenings," a listing of concerts and parties in the Philadelphia area, to which Wink and Dior add the up-coming Raves in Philly, DC, New York, Baltimore, Boston, and every where in between. Listen for ticket giveaways, info on bus trips and rave hot-line numbers or call 895-5917 if you are out of the listening area. (A note about WKDU — the station broadcasts in stereo with 110 watts, soon to be boosted to 800 watts. If you can't hear it now, be patient, more juice is on the way.)

For those who don't get out of bed until after three o'clock, check out the Twilight Zone, hosted by Jessica Rabbit and Cathy Comet every Monday from midnight until three. The occasional home of live bands (Dive), the Twilight Zone is the late night home of WKDU's Rave and House scene. Jessica mixes techno, house and rap one week, while Cathy hits the hard techno on the following week. Missed the concert listings? Rave info? Find it here. Rave on!

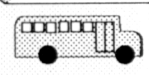

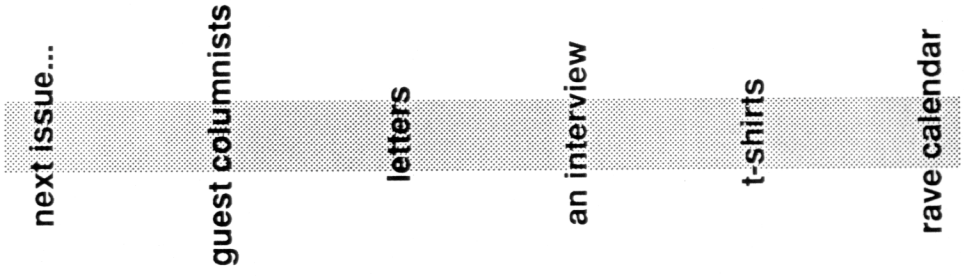

out for Dead by Dawn, they have gone so far as to call OTHER rave promoters as far south as Atlanta, to bad mouth us on their rave lines.

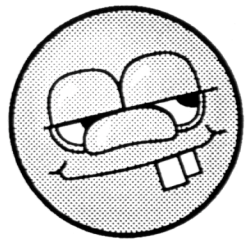
